

Piloting guide for access to the Italian eGovernment services portal, Impresa.gov

1. Click on the “impresa.gov” logo published at the STORK 2.0 Piloting site or insert the following URL in your browser: https://strk.infocamere.it/servizi_impresa/
2. Select the type of access you need: simple authentication to access your personal desktop (all STORK 2.0 countries) or authentication with company credentials to add a new company to your list of represented companies (only for AT, EE, GR, IS, LT, SI and SK).

4. You must then complete the STORK country-specific authentication process (including verification of company credentials if necessary).
5. You may be asked to insert some additional information, as required, such as email, company VAT number

- You will be presented with the [impresagov](https://www.impresagov.it) Personal Desktop and asked to accept the general service conditions.



- Scroll down and press "accept" to complete the registration at the [impresagov](https://www.impresagov.it) portal.



You are now a registered user, with STORK2 credentials and attributes, at the Italian eGov4Business services portal. You may manage your profile information and indicate additional companies which you can represent in eGovernment services.

8. A pilot service in the Environmental sector is currently available to Dutch and Austrian companies registered in the Italian WEEE Registry (Register of Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment producers).
